









# SUPPORTING COMMUNITIES THROUGH THE ARTS

An Ethical Manifesto in Opera as a tool for social engagement

#### Introduction

Culture leverages beauty and relationships to promote individual and social well being. Through networks and the tuning in with communities, the territory is a social catalyst for educational and cultural activities. Verdi Off, in its eighth edition this year, brings theatre, opera and music in the streets, squares, suburbs meeting people and creating opportunities for integration, inclusion and urban regeneration during the period of Festival Verdi. The Ethical Manifesto of Teatro Regio di Parma is born with the aim of creating an even stronger bond with the territory, focusing on places having greater social marginality. Artists and creative teams involved in Festival Verdi productions dedicate part of their time to moments of dialogue with the city meeting places of fragility and associations.

The 3-day plan below introduces members to the activities of Verdi Off, events organized thanks to the Ethical Manifesto, and the two main productions of Festival Verdi 2023. The roundtable will be an opportunity to meet professionals of the field, artists and managers who believe in the importance of the arts as tool for social engagement.
